On asking in person, I am writing this statement, stating that I live at the abovementioned address with my family and am currently practicing law. I have two sons. The elder one is Niraj, and the younger one is Kaushal, who is currently studying. My son Niraj is a qualified CA and is engaged in his profession. Earlier, my son Niraj was working in Surat. Later, he opened his office on the First floor of Surya Flats, Surya Shopping Center, Bharuch, and worked there. He used to live with us. The house we currently live in is in my name, which I purchased in 1974. My son Niraj was married to Kritiben, afterward, they purchased a bungalow Pritamnagar 1, Bharuch, in the year 2001 and lived there.

In the year 2002, I came to know from the newspapers that cases were filed against Home Trade Limited Company regarding buying and

selling of government securities in Valsad, Navsari, Surat, etc., Co operative banks. I also learned that my son Niraj was involved in buying and selling securities with a nationalized bank through Home Trade Limited Company. With the police visiting my house frequently for investigations, he and his wife left the house. I do not know where they are now. They do not visit my house, nor do they stay in the bungalow they had purchased. Currently, I have no information about their whereabouts.

My name is Ashwinbhai Chimanlal Modi, residing at 8/35, business by profession, living at 84 Pritamnagar Society-1, Bharuch.

Upon inquiry, it has been written that I, as mentioned above, reside at this address and sustain myself through my business.

Today, during an investigation, it was revealed that Niraj A. Surti, who resides at Bungalow No. 55 in Pritamnagar-1, Bharuch, has not been residing there for the last one and a half years as the house has been vacant. To the best of my knowledge, he no longer visits here and is believed to be in Surat, Valsad, Navsari, or other districts.

I came to know from a newspaper report that multiple cases of fraud, involving crores of rupees, have been filed against Mumbai Home trade Limited for the illicit trading of government securities, especially in

cooperative banks in Surat, Valsad, Navsari, and other regions. It was also reported that the police from Valsad and Surat are particularly interested in Niraj Surti's involvement in these cases.

As per our knowledge, Niraj Surti is also involved in the aforementioned fraud case. Currently, he is not residing in this house, and I have no information about his whereabouts.

For the last six months I am alone and my younger sister is kranti, who is studying in MMS. I got married in 1985 to Madhuri, daughter of Dineshbhai Tokarshibhai Veera, Dadar. And I have one child, a daughter, who is three and a half years old. And my father Udaybhai G.F.A.H. who holds a degree in Ayurveda. And has been practicing at Madgaon in Mumbai for the past 35 years, and living at the above address, my study is B.com, MMS.

In the year 1997 Feb Applied to Lloyd through mass placement consultant, and I was appointed as senior manager at Lloyd broker. Lloyd remained a company till august 98, then the same company was sold by Mukesh Gupta of Lloyd and taken over by Sanjay Agrawal, after which the company was renamed euro Asian security limited. I got the position of vice president in euro-asian which remained till December 1999, in which I started working on the project of providing financial services through information technology and internet, and I was in this department, at that time there was Mumbai office in Nariman point. After that in December 1999 Euro Asian edge company renamed home trade limited with its registered office in Pune. The work office in Vasi, Navi Mumbai started in December 1999, and in April 2000 got the position of senior vice president, and my boss was Sanjay Aggarwal and I had to do what he said in which my department was retail financial services which included internet and website collects information on it and puts it into the website. Apart from

this, they used to provide information on retail sales of equity shares to the common man. The computer system and technology support was sufficient in which the information coming from 18 different organizations was calculated and well visible to the organizer and how a customer wanted to get information immediately, he worked by placing it on the computer. A facility has been implemented to get a proper idea if any inquiry comes in the call center.

There were regional managers and their sales team across the country, we were training them on how to increase the number of customers. Apart from this, other works related to the project have been done as above to increase sales. All these works are done at the behest of our owner Sanjay Aggarwal and according to his convenience. Also the bond and debt security as well as check contract note and etc. Are not signed at any place. And I was not an authorized signatory just a computer information technology and internet project employee and I have never been to Valsad road

li.li. Shroff Valsad people's operative bank limited and I don't know why my name is in the complaint but my designation is in the website on the internet so by getting my name from the internet website it is wrongly written in the F. I. R. from the First complaint. And secondly, I was not in the debt market department and I do not know its administration and I do not know anything about securities trading and I was not a director in the company and I was not in a responsible position. Used to collect internet and website information and deliver it to customers. On seeing the contract note and check and bill there delivery paper bearing the signatures of Subodh Bhandari, Sanjay Aggarwal and ns Trivedi and I am not involved in the security scam and I have been called by D.Y.S.P. C. I. D Kishor Bele in Nagpur in a home trade case who has questioned me. I have told all the facts truthfully and let go. And in Mumbai also in case of home trade, Deshpande and Belle Saheb C. I. D officer called me to old custom house and took my statement and did not arrest me, and SEBI also

called me but I called them about securities and shares but I don't know anything. So I was let go after questioning coz my department was different. Which was done in the wholesale debt market department in security, bond, contract note etc work in that department. Main Sanjay Aggarwal and Nand kishore Trivedi and Ketan Rade and Kanan Mewawala, Subodh Bhandari and in security buy-sell power department, including Shashank Gopal Ranade and Vijay Himmatlal Modi, Salil Dinkarlal Gandhi and Alan James Mc Crillan who lives in America and Rusal Banktham etc. Who lives in America and Mike aka Manoj Ambalal shah who lives in Bangalore and Dhananjay Hariram Agarwal, the above men held the position of non-executive director in home trade. Sanjay Hariram Aggarwal who is the chairman and chief executive officer and Nand kishore Shankarlal Trivedi who is the executive director and company secretary in home trade and Ketan Kantilal Sheth who is the working director who is knowledgeable about security. Then there was Subodh Bhandari who held the important position of senior vice president authorizing secretary, Kanan Mewawala who held the position of manager in the security department, who was responsible for the security buy-sell and Ketan Rameshbhai Maskaria who served as a junior officer in the security department and who was working under Kanan Mewawala and that four departments I don't have much idea about his working method.

My parents have two children, and I am the eldest. I was born in 1972. My younger sister's name is Naisargi, and she has completed her M.A. She is currently staying at home. I also have uncles. The eldest is Himmatlal Mansukhlal, followed by Dilipbhai Mansukhlal, Chandrakantbhai Mansukhlal, and

Jayeshbhai Mansukhlal. All of them are settled in Ghatkopar, Mumbai, with their families, and they reside there.

I also have two maternal uncles. The elder is Satishbhai Kantilal Mehta, and the younger is Rohitbhai Kantilal Mehta. They live in our hometown, Ahmedabad, where they are employed.

I have two paternal aunts. The eldest is Vimalaben, who is still alive and resides in Ahmedabad, while the younger, Jayaben, passed away ten years ago. I also have two paternal uncles, the eldest being Tarunbhai, who has settled in Ahmedabad.

I was born in Ahmedabad. After my birth, my parents settled in Ghatkopar, Mumbai, for business purposes, so I lived with them. I completed my B.Com at Mumbai University. My First job was at a broker F. I. R.m in Mumbai Court, where I worked as an Assistant Settlement for two to three years. I finished my B.Com in 1992 and continued working until 1995.

In 1995, I worked as an Assistant Settlement Manager at Loyadas Brokerage Limited, located at Nariman Point, Bombay, which dealt with the buying and selling of shares. The CEO was Sanjay Agrawal, under whom I worked. At that time, Nand kishore Trivedi was also with the same company. The company started operating under the name Euro Ocean Security Limited in 1995. Later, in 1999-2000, the aforementioned companies changed their name to Home Trade Limited. Thus, from 1995 until now, I have been working in the Assistant Settlement position at this company. However, in 2000, I was promoted to Officer in the Money Market position. The Home Trade company had its full branch at Nariman Point, Bombay, and then shifted to Vashi, Bombay. After the shift, I got to know Ketan Kantilal Sheth, and Kanak Mevawala also joined the company around that time, which is when I became acquainted with them. During that time, Suvada Bhandari also joined the company, and I became familiar with him as well. Other people also joined the company when it started, but I do not know them, and I am unaware of their names or addresses.

I have been serving in this company since 1995, and it has been transferred under various names. Since then, I am unaware of what activities the company is currently involved in. However, in 2000, the company changed its name to Home Trade and shifted its location to Vashi, Mumbai. At that time, I was appointed as a Money Market Officer by Ketan Sheth, Nand kishore Shankarlal Trivedi, Kanak Mevawala, and took Ι Subodh Bhandari, and responsibilities. During that time, Ketan Sheth served as the Chief Director, Subodh Bhandari as the Director, and Nand kishore Trivedi as the Executive Director and Secretary. Together, they started transactions related to government securities with Peoples Bank in Valsad, which continued late into the night. I will provide more details tomorrow.

My name is Ketan Rameshbhai Mashkariya, age: 30, occupation: Job, Address: village: Sadamada, District: Surendranagar, current address: 191, Block No. 5313, Gitanjali Apartment, Pant nagar, Ghatkopar, East, Mumbai 400075.

The response I provided on 24/06/03 was accurate and correct. Today, upon further questioning, I am providing additional details: "I joined Home Trade Company in December 1999, where my position was as an Officer in Money Market Operations. My starting monthly salary was ₹1,000, which was later increased to ₹12,000 in March-April 2001. Subsequently, in November 2001, my salary was raised to ₹25,000. In April 2002, after reading in the newspaper about the Home Trade Company's collapse, the company shut down. We were not paid for the last two months of work, and the First case was filed in Nagpur with the C. I. D. After that, we have no knowledge of where the Chairmen of 'Home Trade' went.

In "Home Trade," the main person was Sanjay Agrawal, who held the position of CEO, meaning Chief Executive Officer. Second in command was Ketan Kantilal Sheth, who was the working Director of the company, and Nand kishore Shankarlal Trivedi, who served as the Executive Director and Secretary at Home Trade. After that, there was Subodh Bhandari, who was the Senior Vice President and Authorized Signatory, and Kanan Mevawala , who was the Manager of the Debt Market. I do not know Shashank Gopal Rande, nor do I know Vinay Himatlal Modi; I am unaware that he was a director. I also do not know Salil Dinkar Gandhi. I am unfamiliar with Mike alias Manoj Ambalal Shah from Bangalore, but he might have been a Non-Executive Director. I do not know Hiten Bhupendra Shah or Shilpa Hiten Shah, and I have never seen them in the company. I have neither heard of Directors holding positions as them advisors, nor have I seen them in the company.

Also, Dhananjay Hariram Agrawal, who is the brother of Sanjay Agrawal, later came to my knowledge that he is a director. This is something I learned afterward.

Hiren Gada held the position of Senior Vice President at Home Trade and was involved in Information Technology, primarily working on building websites on computers through the internet and providing better services to the public through technology. This was a separate department from the Debt Market Securities Department, and I am not in touch with anyone else who worked with him in Information Technology. Therefore, I do not know them, and Hiren Gada did not hold any position as an Authorized Signatory in the company. He did not have the authority to sign important documents, such as accounts or checks. Since it was a different department, he had no involvement with securities.

Jagruti Ketan Sheth, who is known as the wife of Ketan Sheth, did not hold any position in Home Trade, and I have never seen her in the company. She did not have any authority to sign checks or securities. However, after the Home Trade cases were filed, the CBI in Mumbai

summoned Kanan Mevawala, Jay Mehta, and their associates to the White House for questioning. I was also present there, and the CBI officers questioned me. It was during this time that I saw Jagruti, Ketan Sheth's wife, for the First time and learned about her. Apart from this, I had never seen Jagruti Ketan Sheth before.

I know Niraj Surti, and he worked as a broker for buying and selling securities at Home Trade. After Home Trade was registered, Niraj Surti frequently met with Sanjay Agrawal, Ketan Sheth, Nand kishore Trivedi, and Subodh Bhandari regarding securities matters. Niraj Surti came to me two or three times for contract notes concerning security contracts, and he also frequently met with Kanan Mevawala. Niraj Surti did not hold any official position at Home Trade, but he was a broker involved in buying and selling securities. His wife's name, as you mentioned, is Kruti. However, Niraj Surti did not come to Home Trade, and when I called his home in Bharuch, I learned that his wife's name is Kruti. I have never seen Kruti, and she did not hold any position at Home Trade.

In the Debt Market Department, important tasks related to securities, checks, and bonds carried out. The manager of department was Kanan Mevawala, and Jay Mehta was also a manager, while an individual named Arvindrai worked as a dealer. None of them had any signature authority. Arvindrai and Jay Mehta did not have the authority to countersign any contracts or other documents. However, Subodh Bhandari, Sanjay Agrawal, Ketan Sheth, and Nand kishore Trivedi had the main authority to sign important documents such as checks, contract notes, and other crucial documents. Sanjay Agrawal was in charge of equity shares, while Nand kishore Trivedi handled securities. Ketan Sheth also gave instructions regarding securities matters from time to time, based on which I counter-signed contract notes. Kanan Mevawala also counter-signed, and we would signatures of the higher the obtain authorities. After that, I would enter the counter-signatures into the Valsad People's Bank register, log them in the dispatch book, and send them by courier. In November-December 2001, I delivered contract notes to Valsad Bank and once obtained government securities from Chetan Desai, the Manager at Valsad People's Bank. I brought them to the Home Trade office and, following Kanan Mevawala's instructions, sent them to the respective parties.

My supervisors, Kanan Mevawala, followed by Subodh Bhandari, Nand kishore Shankarlal Trivedi, and Ketan Sheth, would occasionally provide instructions. As a result, I wrote a letter addressed to Valsad Bank on 20/7/2001 to Chetan Desai, which was conversion letter. In this letter, I mentioned @ 10.77% GOI 2020 face value of five crores and (2) 10.25% GOI 2021 face value of six crores fifty lakhs, totaling eleven crores fifty lakhs

in securities, SGL (Subsidized General Ledger). We wrote to Valsad Bank for a physical certificate. This letter contains the authorized signature of Subodh Bhandari and was prepared based on the instructions of Kanan Mevawala, to which I have counter-signed.

On 5/9/2001, there is a delivery letter containing my signature, which was sent based on the instructions of Kanan Mevawala.

On 16/3/2002, N.S. Trivedi wrote a letter to Valsad Bank regarding the securities to be taken, which bears the signature of M.S. Trivedi.

On 18/3/2002, a letter was written stating that the delivery is pending, which I will provide in the SGEL. This letter also bears the signature of N.S. Trivedi.

Contracts numbered 6847, 6851, 6853, 6577, and 6855 bear the signatures of Subodh Bhandari and Sanjay Agarwal, with my counter-signature included. Additionally, the assessment letter dated 6/11/01 has the signature of Subodh Bhandari, along with my counter-signature. Moreover, the authority letter dated 25/1/2002

bears the counter-signature of Kanan Mevawala and the authority signature of Sanjay Agarwal, on which my signature is also present. This was submitted on the dates of 25 and 26/1/2002.

Nand kishore, Sanjay Agarwal, and Kirtan Sheth Bhandari managed the entire financial transactions; I was just a minor employee.

finding work at home due to my illness. I do not know anyone else from Home Trade, such as Sanjay Agarwal, Sheth, Ketan or Subodh Bhandari, but I know Salil Dinkar Ray Gandhi, who is my friend and practices CA. For the last three and a half years, I have suffered from kidney failure, which has caused my abdomen to swell, and I have lost strength in my hands and feet, making long journeys difficult for me. My treatment has been ongoing for the last three years under Dr. B.R. Rameshraw, and my kidneys failed on 05/12/1999. Long journeys and mental stress could lead to any adverse health condition for me. I can suffer from nausea or a decline in health at any time. My treatment is ongoing at S.L. Raheja Hospital in Mumbai, where I have to undergo dialysis checks twice a week for the past three and a half years. I cannot afford the expenses, so I have been seeking help from trustees for my treatment. I have a certificate from Raheja Hospital in Mumbai dated 20/6/2003, and I am presenting the for treatment received today. journeys are not feasible for me; I remain at

Today, when you, Sir, inquired about my husband, Shashank Gopal Rande, I am informing you that my husband has been practicing as a CA for the past 15 years and was associated with Home Trade as a non-executive director. However, he was connected with them in the hope of getting some work but has never actually visited Home Trade. My husband has had only one kidney since birth, and about three and a half years ago, he experienced pain in that kidney. After taking painkillers, the only kidney he had failed. For the last three and a half years, he has been on dialysis and requires dialysis

twice a week. He is under the care of Dr. B. R. Rameshrav, a nephrologist, and is being treated at the specialized S.L. Hospital. Upon reviewing his certificate, it shows that his kidney failed on 05/12/1999, and he has been receiving treatment under my supervision twice a week. The doctor has provided a certificate advising that he should avoid long travel and mental stress, and the bill for the treatment has been submitted as well. Looking at this, it is evident that Shashank Gopal Rande is present but unable to answer any inquiries. Even if any inquiry is conducted, it can be done in my presence, and the police are questioning him under my supervision.

Today, in person, you, Sir, presented me before the Honourable Court, and my police remand has been granted until 2/7/2003. During the remand, statements related to this criminal case were recorded on 24/6/2003, 25/6/2003, and 26/6/2003, which I read and listened to, and they are accurate. Furthermore, I would like to mention that I have been working at Bombay Vashi Home Trade Limited Company since Mukesh Gupta was running LLloyd Brokerage Company, where my position was Assistant Settlement. My duties included verifying shares that came under my responsibility. After that, when the company was sold, it was run under the name Euro Asian Securities, managed by Sanjay Agrawal. I do not know if Ketan Sheth worked there; prior to this, I had not seen Ketan Sheth, and Nand kishore Trivedi worked there at that time, along with Kumari Kanan Mevawala

and Subodh Bhandari, but I am unaware of their roles. After that, the Euro Asian Company operated near Mittal Court, Nariman Point. In the year 2000, Sanjay Agrawal registered Home Trade Limited, transferring it to Vashi, Mumbai, where I managed the debt market operations. My work involved preparing contract notes and creating computer sheets, with serial numbers according to the computer's serial number. Kumari Kanan Mevawala used to sign the counter for the aforementioned contract notes, based on which I prepared them. At that time, Subodh Bhandari, Ketan Sheth, and Nand kishore were not present, and I prepared the contract notes as per their instructions. Ketan Sheth, who worked as a share broker, was in contact with Home Trade, which also operated the Gilt Management Service and Gilt Investment Company. He frequently came to the company and was involved in the share market activities, which led to my acquaintance with him. Subsequently, Ketan Sheth was responsible for government securities and held a senior position at Home Trade.

On 18/3/2002, Nand kishore Trivedi, the Executive Director and Secretary, wrote a letter to Chetan Ramanbhai Desai, the Manager of Valsad Peoples Bank, mentioning that we converted form in would provide a (Subsidiary General Ledger). The ₹9.5 crore physical certificate that I took at that time was duly maintained by me in Home Trade's inward-outward register. This register was seized by C. I. D Crime Economic Offense Wing's police sub-inspector Fit Khedkar, and he had taken my statement regarding that time. Today, upon visiting the C. I. D Economic Cell at Mumbai's Covered Market for an investigation, it was found that Khedkar Saheb has been transferred, and a working police inspector has been appointed in his place. They provided me with a Xerox copy of my statement and mentioned that the register record was taken only for my case, and the original register was transferred to Pune Panthri Police Station. My statement was taken by Superintendent of Police Pradeep at Pune Panthri Police Station. Later, when a team conducted a physical check at my house,

no documents related to Home Trade were found.

By asking in person I am writing that I am living with my family at the above mentioned work place and currently I am working as an accountant in Sun App Wartronics private limited Dadar Mumbai. Before that I was working as a work manager in Lloyd Brokerage company on temporary basis. Because I studied chartered accountant and worked there for certificate.

I am born in the year 1965 to Bhupendrabhai Bapalal Shah at Vadodara my mother's name is Saroj ben who passed away in the year 1997. I have one brother named Dhirenbhai who currently lives with his family at Santacruz Prayog Society Santacruz East Mumbai-55. My sister in law's name is Sunitaben. I have no sisters, my maternal uncle is Vinod Chhatrapati, whose father's name is Maganlal who lives in Mumbai Kandivali. I have

Surati (17) Shreemati Kruti Niraj Surati and Shah my wife Shilpa Hiten and communication that the complaint given against me dated 6/6/2002 was read out to me, I state that I do not know the complainant Chetan Ambalal Desai who is the manager of Valsad Bhagwan Das Bridge Jivandas Shroff Valsad people's Co operative Bank mentioned in the said complaint and with me in the complaint. I know the said accused Nand kishore Shankarlal Trivedi very well with whom I worked in 1997

at Lloyd brokerage so I know. Also I know Sanjay Hariram Agrawal, but I have no acquaintance with him, I do not know any other accused except that I have met him once or twice. I don't know what happened to that company after I left the practice at Lloyd Brokerage in 1997. I don't know what happened to this Lloyd Brokerage company which was running in the name of Mukesh Gupta after he left the company. But Home Trade limited company operating in Mumbai started from the year 2000 and after getting the (Gujarat) police information about investigation regarding Home Trade, I have given the information of home trade company limited to V.S. Khanvelkar When I got the copies of the certificate Of ROC, I came to know that Sanjay Hariram Agarwal who had set up a Home Trade company in Mumbai. I am also not aware of what transactions they have done with Co operative banks in Maharashtra and Gujarat on behalf of home trade limited, but what I have come to know so far is the sale of government securities of valsad Co operative bank worth Rs. 28 crores and the purchase of new securities. Purchased from Valsad people's bank. Neither I nor my wife have done any job in home trade limited and I have no idea where home trade limited is located. But according to you, it is known that Home Trade company Vashi is located in Mumbai.

When I was working in Lloyd Brokerage company I was known by Nand kishore Trivedi and Sanjay Agarwal so they needed share holder form to register the company so they gave my name to register Lloyd Brokerage company I believe I am not from Gujarat Bank in valsad I don't even know where it is. When I was working in Lloyd Brokerage, test market and capital market was handled by Nand kishore Trivedi, so I know his signature very well. Neither I nor my wife worked in home trade limited. Works at home. I believe that the complainant has also made us accused by receiving money from Lloyd Brokerage when the company was running at the brokerage stage. The facts stated in the complaint are all post-incorporation transactions of home trade co. Ltd. After selling the securities, it is the duty of the seller to transfer them in the name of the owner. The seller makes the transfer from the Reserve Bank and reports it to NSE. That is, the National Stock Exchange is done. I don't have any special information other than that information I know.

I got married with Shilpa known person to Rajinikant bhai town paria residence Madras Chennai in the year 1994. I have two children one baby girl and one baby boy. I don't have brother-in-law but I have sister-in law. Who stay with her in-laws in Bangalore. My wife Shilpa's passport number is k00- 787 dated 9/2/95. Which has been expired in December-January 2002. I have provided the xerox copy of this. Also my passport number b-6938 dated 6/11/93 which is valid till 28/12/03. I am submitting its xerox copy too. And I submitting the xerox copy of the information I have obtained from the registered companies since 1993 relating to Home Trade. I am also presenting xerox of Europe Asian company certificate.

I have a case registered against me and my wife Shilpa and I have filed a form

dated 12/3/2003 seeking anticipatory bail in the Honourable Valsad Sessions Court. The anticipatory bail application dated 25/3/2003 has been disallowed from the Honourable court. I am also submitting the copy of the same. In the case filed by Valsad people's bank against me and my wife, no evidence has been found against me before the commission of the crime as well as at present. So my statement has been taken and I undertake to be present before you or any other Investigation.

## Anticipatory Bail Application : :-

Presented by advocate R V Damoli on 21/03/2003 anticipatory (1) The present application has been filed on behalf of both the accused and it has been submitted that on the basis of the complaint given by main complainant Chetanbhai Desai as manager of Valsad People's co operative Bank Limited, the police registered the First crime at valsad city police station I Crime Register no. 119/2002 I.P.C Section 467, 406, 409, 420, 421, 422, 423, 120b and 34 arrested the other accused when the present applicant no. 1 named in the complaint as accused no. 5 and the present applicant as accused no. 14 the present accused never served as a Director in Home Trade Limited Company, along with the accused mentioned in the complaint there is no relationship. Complaints are late and the present accused has not given any details in the complaint as to what part of the order he

has served. There is no First spectacular case against the accused. There is no theory of collective responsibility in criminal cases. There is no evidence of conspiracy. Maharashtra as well as in Gujarat, there have been complaints about some acts of home trade limited company and the investigation is ongoing. The accused have no connection with the criminal act of the company and there is a possibility that the present accused are wrongly arrested by the police even though they are not directors in the company. Both the present applicants are husband and wife and have minor children who are permanent residents of the present applicant have never been called by the police for the purpose of investigation in the Mumbai case or in the present case inspite of long time since the complaint was filed and therefore there is evidence and reasonable grounds to release the accused on anticipatory bail.

(2) After hearing the arguments of both the lawyers appearing with the investigation papers, the public prosecutor took the investigation papers for sale.

Briefly considering the facts of the (3) case of the prosecution, on the basis of the complaint given by the complainant, it has been revealed at the end of the investigation that all the accused mentioned in the complaint formed a criminal conspiracy to commit the crime in collusion with each other and set up a company named Home Trade limited in Mumbai Vashi area, in which the accused are directors, chairman and various positions include director etc. Chartered director executive of accountants holding government securities buysell. Sheth Bhagwan Das of Valsad Brij Jivan Das Valsad Peoples co.op. Bank limited to the complainant and witnesses during the period from 15/5/2000 to 19/3/2000 original accused no. 1 and 4 and 10 to 12 with the complainant at different times of purchase of government securities. Purchased government security from the complainant by entering into deals and received an investment of rs.11 crores for obtaining new security total contact notes of

27,50,00,000/- dated 30/1/2002 and purchased at face value on 13/3/2002 28,75,00,000 in excess of the amount those accused did not pay the complainant bank all the accused in mutual help gave false contact notes on the blank security form of reserve bank of India took xerox papers of old security bonds and wrote wrong numbers of reserve bank on the blank form gave the government security money to the complainant bank all the accused for their personal benefit using the public money for his own personal benefit, despite knowing that there was no balance in his account, he issued different checks in the name of the Federal bank were issued to the complainant bank and no amount was found to be in the account representing the cheques. According to that, the police have presented a charge sheet against the arrested accused in the court of chief judicial magistrate of Valsad on the basis that the accused have committed the crime of betrayal, fraud and false documents with the complainant bank.

In this case a fact comes on record (4) that the present accused has not been mentioned by the complainant in his complaint in which specific position they are working and the fact that all the accused are directors is written in the complaint. This work reveals the fact that both the present accused are working in home trade limited by selling the investigation papers. Some documents have been produced by the accused along with the present bail application. And according to those documents from the registrar of search report companies has been produced that both the present accused do not hold any position as directors and both the present accused did not hold any position as directors in home trade limited. Even considering that fact, it is prime evident that the present applicant no. 1 is associated with the company and the fact that the applicant no. 2 is a non-executive independent director is also evident from the investigation and in that position he was involved in the criminal act along with the other accused persons. The submission of the accused that they played no part is not acceptable. In this work it has been contended on behalf of the accused that there is no clarification as to what part the present applicant have played except that only the complaint mentions the accused as directors and therefore there is no prime evidence against the applicant and relying on some judgments presented on behalf of the applicants. Both the applicants have been requested to be released on anticipatory bail.

against the petitioners in this case, it appears that the First applicants along with the other accused had entered into some financial dealings with the complainant bank and had acquired trust and confidence to give the amount of government security obtained from the complainant bank after obtaining a large sum of money. Also in this case, the fact that checks in the name of federal bank were given to the complainant bank on behalf of the accused and the cheques were returned due to non-balance in the account is also First sight

presented to the criminal man. For which act the present applicant cannot be held to be in any way involved. The fact that the accused are ca also emerges from the investigation papers and it cannot be held that the present accused are unaware of the details of insufficient deposit in the bank. The police have filed a charge sheet against other arrested accused and the existing accused are mentioned in the column of accused not arrested. The present applicant are shown to be fugitives as per column. In this work, the investigating officer tried to contact the present accused by selling the investigation papers, but the fact of nonavailability of the accused also comes on record and therefore, if anticipatory bail is granted to the present accused, in the investigation against them. There possibility of a interception. The involved in this crime which is more than 28 crores and along with it the reserve bank bond whose xerox copy has wrongly written the numbers in the name of the reserve bank, the intention to give the embezzled amount to the

complainant bank and not the amount involved in the crime is one sight revealed.

- (6) In the argument for the accused AIR 2000 supreme court judgment page no.754 cited, where two different complaints were made in respect of the same offence, the later complaint filed in I. P. C. Sections 406, 420 are held to be quashed but in the present application it is to be seen whether prime offense is committed against the accused, the above judgment does not help the accused in any way and in para no. 13 of the above judgment by selling the investigation papers. What is observed is not acceptable at this stage.
- (7) 1980 (2) supreme court cases page no.
  665 in favor of the accused in which
  anticipatory bail should be granted keeping in
  view the constitutional provision of personal
  liberty. Even if we consider the above
  principle, the prime evidence of the accused
  involved in the crime does not deserve the
  benefit of anticipatory bail considering the

It is the request report of the B.U. Gosai, Valsad city police station,

Regarding the afore mentioned subject and reference, in Crime Registration Number I-119/02 at Valsad City Police Station, under I. P. C Sections 420, 467, etc., as per the instructions of the Police Inspector of Valsad City Police Station, a police party was dispatched from here on 14/06/2003 to bring the accused, Nand kishore Shankarlal Trivedi, through a transfer warrant. On 16/06/2003, the Judicial Magistrate, First Class, First Court, Nagpur, Maharashtra, was approached in connection with the transfer warrant, which had previously been presented by Investigating

Officer L D Sosa, Police Sub-Inspector, Women's Cell/LCB, on 06/06/2013. According to Valsad Court dispatch number 1144/3 dated 13/06/03, a request was made to the Honorable court to hand over custody of the accused, Nand kishore Shankarlal Trivedi. The Nagpur Court informed that the CBI/BSFC in Mumbai had previously applied in Crime Number 4E/2002, involving I. P. C Sections 120B, 406, 405, 409, 467, and 468, in a bank fraud case. It was noted that custody of the accused was previously handed over to Mumbai CBI, and the decision regarding this handover is pending. Therefore, it has been indicated that the accused will First be returned from CBI Mumbai, after which the handover of custody to Valsad will processed.

Furthermore, the transfer warrant issued in this case is not appropriate. As per Section 267 of the Criminal Procedure Code, proceedings under this section are necessary, and an order (Form No. 36) instructing the presentation of an individual in jail to answer the charges is required. This order from the relevant court

must be sent with a request to the in-charge of Central Jail, Nagpur, Maharashtra, through the aforementioned Nagpur Court, to facilitate the transfer of custody of the accused. It has been stated that until an order is issued to the jailer per Form No. 36, further proceedings will not take place. In this matter, the Maharashtra Government has appointed Mr. P.K. Satyanath, Government Pleader and Public Prosecutor in Nagpur, as a Special Public Prosecutor. He has taken the necessary steps to implement the above instructions.

The aforementioned accused is in Central Jail, Nagpur, Maharashtra, and is under the custody of the Judicial First Class Magistrate Court, Nagpur, in connection with Crime Registration Number 101/2002 at Ganesh peth Police Station, Nagpur City.

Currently, the order has been issued to hand over the accused to the CBI in Mumbai for investigation. Police Inspector Mehra of CBI, Walkeshwar, Mumbai, is conducting the investigation for this case. Their Mumbai phone number is 23635004, and PSI Bajpai is assisting

them. By contacting them, it can be determined how long the accused will remain in their custody. In this case, the accused's lawyer, B.C. Pal from Nagpur, is representing the accused and regularly appears in the relevant court. Upon being questioned in person, I gave my statement regarding this case in front of you, Sir, on June 24, 2003, June 25, 2003, June 26, 2003, June 27, 2003, June 28, 2003, June 29, 2003, and June 30, 2003, during my police remand. You read it to me, and I confirm that it is accurate and true. Additionally, I state that in Valsad City Police Station, Crime Register No. 119/02, under I. P. C sections 406, 409, 420, 421, 422, 423, 467, 120B, and 34, a case has been registered against Home Trade Limited Mumbai's chairman, Sanjay Agrawal, and 19 others, including myself, by Bank Manager Shri Chetan Ramanbhai Desai. Following the registration of this case, the accused Sanjay Hariram Agrawal, Ketan Kantilal Sheth, and Subodh Chand Dayal Bhandari were arrested on different dates, and they are currently in police custody, as you informed

me. In front of you, the bank manager presented details related to Home Trade investigation. Among these, in January 2002, I personally obtained securities worth 9.5 crores from Bank Manager Chetanbhai at the bank, for which I signed the office copy. Upon taking the 9.5 crore securities from Valsad, I recorded the same in the Home Trade company register at that time. These securities were deposited with Home Trade, and as instructed by Kanan Mevawala, who held the managerial position, I dispatched them to the respective parties as per her guidance. I had come to Valsad Bank to deliver the contract note for each transaction, and I confirm from bank records that I did not use the 9.5 crore securities for personal purposes. Instead, as an employee of Home Trade Company Limited, handling these securities was part of my duty. I regularly followed instructions from my superiors, including the Manager, Vice Chairman, and President. During my employment, I received a monthly salary of ₹25,000. I believe the records of securities I took are with Home Trade Company and may have been transferred when the initial case was registered with Nagpur C. I. D Branch. Based on those records, I can provide further information. I took securities worth 9.5 crore rupees with certificate numbers AD - 13, 168, 169, 170, 171, 6, 7, 8, and 308, totalling 9.5 crore rupees. I will make a copy of these records based on the Xerox documents presented by Valsad Peoples Cooperative Bank to show which parties currently hold these securities.

During my police remand, I am giving my statement in the presence of the officer, confirming that in Home Trade Limited, Sanjay Agrawal served as the CEO (Chief Executive Officer), under whom Kumari Kanan Mevawala worked as the manager. I am well-acquainted with her, and I can confirm that the countersignature marked "KM" on the contract note is indeed hers. Additionally, I recognize the signature of Subodh Chand Dayal Bhandari, who was a director, as his signature appears on the xerox copy of the contract note. Furthermore, I recognize the signatures of Nand kishore Shankarlal Trivedi on both the contract note and the bank's resolution, which confirms that these signatures are indeed his. I am familiar with the signatures of Sanjay Agrawal, Kumari Kanan Mevawala, and Nand kishore Trivedi on the contract notes, where my own signature is also

present, but there are no signatures of Ketan Sheth on these documents. However, on March 16, 2002, Bhagwan Das Sheth was present at the Valsad People's Co operative Bank, where he signed as a representative of Home Trade Limited under the names (1) N.S. Trivedi, (2) Ketan Sheth, and (3) Kumari Kanan Mevawala, each with their respective signatures. This is the First time I saw Ketan Sheth's signature, I SO cannot definitively confirm authenticity. Nonetheless, I do recognize the signatures of N.S. Trivedi and Kanan Mevawala, as they were present at the bank. I am aware that Ketan Sheth held the position of director at Home Trade Limited and handled debt market operations, managing the company's investments and government securities trading. However, I am unsure whether the funds from the bank intended for government securities were reinvested in new securities. Finally, I have already provided detailed information regarding the securities worth ₹9.5 crore, which I was responsible for acquiring, in my previous statements to the officer.

Against Home Trade Limited, various cases filed across Maharashtra. response, I have visited Nagpur and Pune, where my statements have been recorded by the investigating officers. Additionally, statement was taken in Mumbai at the Crafford Market Police Station, following a complaint filed by Raghuvanshi Co operative Society. In all the cases across Maharashtra, my name has not been listed as an accused. However, I am uncertain under what circumstances I have been listed as an accused in Gujarat. In Gujarat, besides Valsad Bank, I have not visited any other banks in Navsari, Surat, Borsad, or elsewhere. The operations of Home Trade Limited were primarily overseen by Sanjay Agrawal, Subodh Bhandari, Nand kishore Trivedi, and Kumari Kanan Mevawala-all of whom I know well. I am also acquainted with Dhananjay Agrawal, Sanjay's brother. Regarding Home Limited's dealings with Co operative banks, I am not informed of any requirements to report securities transactions to the Reserve Bank of India or the National Stock Exchange. According

to the complainants, I was not involved in any government securities transactions for Home Trade Limited. However, as I have previously stated, I did take ₹9.5 crore worth of securities from Valsad People's Bank.

In Maharashtra, transactions on behalf of Home Trade Limited involving deposits, securities placements, and withdrawals were handled by Sanjay Agrawal, Nand kishore Trivedi, Subodh Bhandari, and Ketan Sheth. Home Trade Limited maintained accounts in various banks, including HDFC Bank, Bank of Maharashtra, U T I Bank, Janata Sahakari Bank, and Federal Bank in Mumbai. However, I do not know the specific account numbers of these bank accounts.

The Honourable Court instructed us to appear on 16/6/2003; however, due to another assignment, we sent Police Sub-Inspector B. U. Gosai, as per the written order of the Police Superintendent. On that date, he was present at the GMF Nagpur Court connection with the CBI case from Mumbai. After that, you will be handed over custody as stated by the District Government Pleader and the Public Prosecutor in Nagpur, which was also confirmed by the Nagpur Court.

The Nagpur Court GMF and the Public Prosecutor verbally stated that the accused is

in judicial custody. Therefore, proceeding under Section 267 of the CR. P. C, instructions were given to address the warrant through the Nagpur Court to the Central Jail, Nagpur, in accordance with Form 36. Incidents related to Home Trade have been registered in Maharashtra in places such as Pune, Nagpur, Mumbai, Wardha, Osmanabad, and in Gujarat at Surat Udhna Police Station, Varachha, Navsari, Anand, etc. In these cases, Ketan Ramesh Maskariya has served as a Money Market Officer in the Debt Market Securities for Home Trade. He took an assessment letter

dated 20/7/2001, a letter dated 05/09/01, contract note numbers 6847, 6851, 6853, 6577, 6855, 6849, an assessment letter 6/11/2001, a transfer letter on will, and a physical security GI-O worth ₹95 crore dated 25/1/2002 from Valsad along with authorization letter. He has signed counter signatures on contract notes and completed important tasks on the above-mentioned letters. Accused Sanjay Agrawal, Ketan Sheth, Subodh Bhandari, Nand Kishore Trivedi, and others as with Kanak Mevawala, directors, along collaborated to gain people's trust and entered into a security contract of face value ₹275 crore with Valsad People's Bank. They took the original security from Valsad People's Bank and sold it to other banks at market value, using the money elsewhere instead of repaying it to the Valsad bank or fulfilling the security contract note, causing losses to Valsad People's Bank. Among the accused, Sanjay Agrawal, Ketan Sheth, and Subodh Bhandari are in judicial custody without having received regular bail. If accused Ketan Ramesh Maskeriya is released on bail, there is no likelihood that the bank's funds will be recovered in any way. No material evidence has been recovered in this case. Today, upon further questioning from you, I would like to state that there were three people present with you, and they introduced themselves: Chairman Sameer Shah, Director Sameer Zaveri, and Manager Ajit Desai. In their presence and in my presence, you reviewed my and Shilpa's statements, and upon questioning in their presence, I would like to clarify that in 1996, the company had sold NRI shares through Loped Brokerage, and funds were sent to them, under the advisory of Nand Kishore, who was the company's Vice President and worked whenever required. I was introduced to Sanjay Agrawal through Nand Kishore at an office near the Mial Court at Nariman Point. After 1996, Nand Kishore Trivedi and Sanjay Agrawal either met again for other purposes or for Loped

Brokerage, which later became Euro Asian. As for Euro Asian becoming Home Trade, I have no knowledge, and neither my wife nor I hold any position or involvement as a director, officer, or any other role in Home Trade. In 1997-98, Nand Kishore Trivedi had called, stating that he was forming a limited company that required seven shareholders, and requested to list our names as shareholders, for which he provided the necessary share funds. I did not provide any funds for the shares, nor do I possess share certificates, and I am unaware of their dates, but this is unrelated to Home Trade. I do not know Ketan Sheth, Subodh Bhandari, Kanan Mevawala, or Ketan Maskariya, nor any of their directors, and I have not conducted any activities with them. Upon investigation in the presence of the bank manager, chairman, and director, it was clarified that neither my wife Shilpa nor I have any involvement in any offense related to Home Trade. The information linking us is false.

I. P. C Sections 406, 409, 420, 421, 422, 467, 120B, and 34. The facts of the case are that the complaint was filed by Chetan Ramanbhai Desai, Manager of Valsad People's Cooperative Bank. In this case, the accused Ketan Kantilal Sheth, Sanjay Hariram Agrawal, Nand Kishore Shankarlal Trivedi, Subodh Dayal Bhandari, and Kanan Mevawala had registered Home Trade Private Limited Company. The company conducted transactions involving government securities bought and sold from the bank, as per contract notes, totaling ₹27,50,00,000 in securities transactions. These contract notes prepared by the aforementioned individuals, who committed criminal breach of trust and fraud against Valsad People's Bank in relation to the said amount. Market Security Money Market Officer Accused No. (6) stated in Charge Sheet Column No. (2) bearing contract note a prepared designation of Manager in Small Test Market Security Department which on Contract Note No. 6847, 6851, 6856, 6577, 6855 and 6849 and also on the letter of buy-sell of the security and on the adjustment letter and on the transfer letter and on last date 25/1/02 came to Valsad People's Bank Rs.9,50,00,000/- G.I.O of taking security from the written letter of the above accused and at the request of the co-accused deposited the security in "Home Trade" company which was searched along with the banks. At the hint and help of his sent co-accused, the complainant prepared a false contract note to the bank in which he counter signed and signed the important document also accused No. (9), (10), (12) mentioned in charge sheet column No. (2) who are unclear stayed in foreign countries and gave advice and guidance to the co-accused and took Valsad People's Bank into confidence, all the accused kept in touch with each other and lured the First bank to buy government

security and its money as well as new bonds with the promise that they would get more profit and took the government security and cash for buying new bonds Rs. 11000000/- of face value purchased on Contract note of total Rs.27,50,00,000/- received on trust Contract Note No. 7165 dated 30/1/2002 and 7143 dated 13/3/2002, the accused did not pay the consideration amount of Rs 21,75,21,758.33 to the complainant bank, they gave wrong contract notes with the help of each other, generated wrong numbers of Reserve Bank of India and put those numbers of Reserve Bank on xerox papers of old security bonds, gave blank forms to the complainant bank, government security and Money given to take new security, by intentionally not paying that money to the complainant bank, fraudulently using that money elsewhere, fraudulently with holding the money due to the complainant bank, the accused mentioned in column number (4) prepared a false contract note and intentionally counter signed it, Rupees 28,75,21,758.33 each of the accused used the public money for their own personal

# ::Judgment::

(1) The investigating officer under Valsad City Police Station Crime Registration No. I - 119/02 I. P. C Section 420, 421, 422, 423, 120B, 34 filed an application dated 1/7/2003

before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, to obtain the custody of accused Nandkishor Shankarlal Trivedi who is under Ganesh Peth Police Station under First Crime Registration No. 101/02, Nagpur city, in the custody of the Judicial Magistrate. To obtain his custody under the provision of Section 267 of Criminal Procedure Code filed an application seeking execution of production warrant in Form No. 67 before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Valsad which was rejected so filed an Revision Application to the government under section 397 of Criminal Procedure Code.

on the complaint Registered by Chetanbhai Ramanlal Desai before Valsad City Police Station under First Crime Registration No. 119/02, crimes punishable under I. P. C Sections 406, 409, 420, 421, 422, 423, 467, 120B and 34 have been registered. Nand kishore Shankarlal Trivedi and others are accused in this crime, but this Nand kishore under Ganesh Peth Police Station in the case of First Crime Registration No. 101/02 is in the Judicial

custody of Nagpur Judicial Magistrate Court, so the Investigating Officer has made the above application to bring them in this crime.

(3) The following issues arise for the decision of this application.

Points:

- 1. Whether this revised order passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Valsad is illegal, unsuitable or unreasonable?
- 2. What order?
- 3.
- 4. My decision on the above point is as follows:
  - 1. Positive
  - 2. As per final order.

## REASONS

## Point no. 1:

(5) On behalf of the government, Learned Additional Public Prosecutor Mitaben Patel's argument was heard and the brother of the accused Nand kishore himself was present in the court and the investigating officer PSI Shri

Sosa was heard and the record of the trial court was taken onto reading.

As informed above, the above crime has been registered against this applicant and 18 other persons and according to the investigating officer in this crime, this Nand kishore Shankarlal Trivedi is required to be arrested and prosecuted for this crime and from the judicial custody of the Judicial Magistrate First Class of Nagpur before the Judicial Magistrate First Class of Valsad under provision of section 467 of Criminal Procedure Code. He cannot be brought into custody in this crime except by the production warrant of Form-36 by proceeding as per the provisions of Section 467. Now if we look at the application submitted on 1/7/03 by the investigating officer before the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, Valsad, the same information have also been mentioned in it. In this application, the order passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class dismissing application is as follows. PSI L D Sosa was heard by the application, read the report

submitted by PSI Sosa, and read section 267 of Criminal Procedure Code, considered provisions under section 267 of Criminal Procedure Code, this report at this stage is not admissible, the demand as per the report at present is hereby rejected. In view of the order of the Learned Judicial Magistrate First Class, no reason has been given for rejection of the said application. But at this stage the said demand is rejected is only written, but no reason has been given for the rejection. Generally a judicial order on any application should be under speaking so that application whether granted or not granted the reasons for rejecting an application should be given, but no such reasons have been given in the order so the order is not enforceable. Further, from the record of the trial court, before this revision application was filed by the investigating officer on 13/6/2003, the application seeking transfer warrant rejected and the judgment of the Judiciary Magistrate First Class Valsad dated 3/6/2003 and dated 13/6/2003 which had issued a transfer

warrant in the Court of Judiciary Magistrate. Nagpur, but in the absence of possession as per this transfer warrant, the present date for proceeding under Section 267 Criminal Procedure Code is presented on 1/7/2003, on this date 2/7/2003 the Investigating Officer submitted another application conveying that they have deposited the previous transfer warrant and on that basis they should provide the custody of the accused for which he filed a list in English for transfer of the accused which was approved and on the basis of the transfer warrant dated 2/7/2003 The transfer warrant as per this application has been issued. In view of all these facts, it appears that the Judicial Magistrate of Valsad has no objection to bring the accused Nand kishore Shankarlal Trivedi from the custody of Nagpur City Judicial Magistrate First Class to the Valsad City Police Station for the purpose of crime registered under First crime registration number 119/02, but for the same purpose they As stated above, the earlier application was allowed and the transfer warrant was issued.

In such circumstances, the reason is not understandable as no reason has been given in this order as to why the application dated 1/7/2003 has been cancelled by the Investigating Officer, but this order is of a unclear nature when indeed it follows from the transfer warrant that the Judiciary Magistrate First Class considers his conduct in issuing the transfer warrant that the possession of this accused should be brought to Valsad City Police Station Crime Registration No. 119/02. The application dated 1/7/2003 should have been allowed, but instead of doing so, application has been dismissed without stating any reasons, the order is not proper, therefore I answer point No. 1 in the positive way.

Thus, as stated above, this order is improper and deserves to be cancelled, so if the application of the Inquiry Officer dated 1/7/2013 is allowed, it is fair and reasonable to cancel this order. Accordingly, I make the following final order.
